ECVIM-CA), surgery (5 ECVS), emergency and intensive care (2 ECVECC), diagnostic imaging (3 ECVDI), anaesthesiology (1 ECVAA), dermatology (1 ECVD), reproduction (1 ECAR), ophthalmology (2 ECVO), cardiology (1 ECVIM-CA cardiology) and nutrition (1 ECVN).
